Dear Mr. Cranford;

Upon receiving your request to sample your lime-calcium product and analyze it for E. coli, PrimusLabs.com referred to the "Official Methods of the AOAC International" published by the Association of Official Analytical Chemists for the appropriate method.

However, we were unable to find an approved or peer-reviewed method for any microbiological analyses that could be performed on your product. Additionally, due to the elevated pH of your product the quantity of acid that would have to be utilized to neutralize the sample for analysis would likely act as a "kill" step to any microorganisms thus invalidating the analytical result.
